












Replace rib of 11ft cantilever umbrella

Steps				
Remove canopy and pull out rope	<p>Unscrew the light connector when umbrella is open; take off the lower hub and untie the rope</p> 	<p>Depart the frame from head hinge, and pull out the rope from upper pole</p> 	<p>Take off canopy</p> 	
Replace ribs	<p>Remove the 8pcs screws from lower hub when frame is open</p> 	<p>Remove the screws on upper hub when frame is close</p> 	<p>To replace the broken rib</p> 	
Assemble hubs	<p>Put back screws to assemble the upper hub</p> 		<p>Put back screws to assemble the upper hub</p> 	
Put on canopy	<p>Put canopy on frame</p> 	<p>Buckle the velcro and zip up</p> 	<p>Do not put rib into pocket at this moment</p> 	

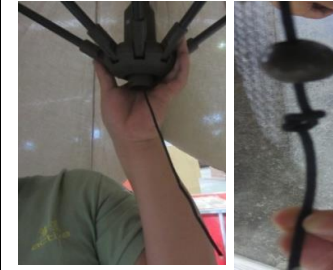
Thread the rope through the upper pole, pay attention to the direction



Fix the frame to the head hinge when frame is close. Put all the screws, bolts, back to original place



Pull out rope from lower hub. Fix back the place kick, and tie a knot at 5cm of the rope end.



Assemble the head hinge

Fix the lower hub



Put the rib into pocket
