




Umbrella Base with Wheels

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

**IMPORTANT, RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE:
READ CAREFULLY**

NOT FOR COMMERCIAL USE**



CAUTION:

Before assembling the umbrella base, read this manual and follow the safety instructions.

CARE INSTRUCTION:

Clean gently with environmentally - friendly soap solution and water using a sponge. Do not use abrasive materials, wire brushes, chemicals, cleansers or bleach. Do not use a pressure washer. Rinse well. Allow to air dry.


SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Do not use the umbrella base with wheels before filling it with weight.
2. The heavier the umbrella base, the more stable it will be.
3. Do not use in windy conditions. Never tilt your umbrella in windy conditions. Always close and remove the umbrella from the base in windy conditions.
4. Use the umbrella base with wheels on flat surfaces only. The locking wheels are meant to keep the umbrella base with wheels locked in place on flat surfaces. The locking wheels are not meant for locking the umbrella base with wheels in place on sloped surfaces.
5. Keep the wheels locked except when moving your umbrella base with wheels. The locking wheels may wear down over time making the brake mechanism less effective. Check for wear and replace the locking wheels when necessary.
6. Do not move, lock, or unlock the umbrella base with wheels with bare feet.
7. The umbrella base with wheels is not designed to roll in sand or grass ground. Submerging the wheels in sand or grass will clog the ball bearings.
8. Do not allow children to play with or operate the umbrella base with wheels.


Before assembly, have 12 bricks (recommended size 8 x 3 5/8 x 2 1/4 in) and 50 lbs of sand ready.


NOTE: Parts shown on parts list are not to scale.

ASSEMBLING THE BASE



Step 1 - Fasten Wheels to Base Substructure.

Note: Use screws with washers to secure four wheels. Tighten screws firmly but do not over-tighten. Over-tightening may strip the holes. Please note the slots for locking wheels and non-locking wheels are different. Make sure wheels fixed at right slots.




Step 2 - Fill the Base with Bricks and Sand.

Cover the center hole with the paper cover to prevent sand from entering this area. Place 12 bricks (see Brick Specifications) in the Base Substructure in the pattern shown. Fill sand all around and between the bricks. Fill sand up to the height of the edge of the Base Substructure.

Note: Sand-only can not reach the total weight 125lbs, we recommended using bricks and sand to reach weight 125lbs. Rocks can also be used as long as the total weight could reach 125lbs.

Remove paper cover from the center hole.



LOCKING WHEELS INSTRUCTIONS



Step 3 - Install the base cover.

Step 4 - Install the Stem.

Insert the Stem into the Base Cover and twist.




Locking device

Reducer A




Step 5 - Select Reducer.


The unit comes with a Reducer that fits a 1.38 inch, 1.5 inch or 1.9 inch diameter umbrella pole.

After choosing the correct reducer then insert umbrella pole in stem, turn the handle of locking device clockwise to secure the umbrella. The handle is equipped with a button on the end.

Push the button and pull the handle out at the same time and you can rotate the handle to align with the stem without loosening the stem from the pole.



1. To lock – press down the pedal on the locking wheels.



2. To unlock - Lift up the pedal on the locking wheels.

MOVE WITH CAUTION:

- Base is suitable for 3.36M / 11ft Market Umbrella, or other umbrellas under 18kgs / 39.68 lbs
- Make sure umbrella is in closed position and free of objects before moving base.

LETTER OF WARRANTY

Please be advised that the manufacturer provides a two-year warranty that the umbrella base with wheels will be free from defects in original materials and workmanship.

Frame

Frames are warranted to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of two years. Damage to frames or welds due to improper assembly or exposure to water and sub-freezing temperatures is not covered. Do not allow water to accumulate inside frames.

Finish

The finish is warranted against peeling, cracking, or blistering for a period of two years, provided the unit has not been scratched or abraded. Scratches and chips resulting from abnormal wear and tear are not covered.

Note: All operation should be according to the instruction manual.

* This warranty DOES NOT COVER the following items:

Failure caused by unreasonable or abusive use; failure caused by neglect of reasonable and necessary care; acts of nature (including but not limited to wind, hurricanes, tornadoes, and storms) are not covered by this warranty.

The product is not covered by this warranty after two years from the date of purchase.

AUSTRALIA: Our goods come with guarantees that cannot be excluded under the Australian Consumer Law. You are entitled to a replacement or refund for a major failure and for compensation for any other reasonably foreseeable loss or damage. You are also entitled to have the goods repaired or replaced if the goods fail to be of acceptable quality and the failure does not amount to a major failure.
